FORUM RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

- 1. The meeting will begin at 7pm and run until 9:00 pm, If there is a need to extend the time, the Moderator will confirm this is acceptable to both Candidates before granting the extension, to a maximum of 9:30 pm.
- 2. The Moderator will introduce, by name, each Candidate. They will not present a background as introduction for each candidate. Instead, each candidate is welcome to include a brief biography as part of his or her opening statement.
- 4. The speaking order for the opening statements will be by chance, with the Moderator drawing one name at random from a ballot in the presence of all Candidates for the meeting. This will be done approximately 15 minutes before the start of the meeting. Closing statements will be presented in the reverse order. This way, the speaking orders are fair to all.
- 5. Each Candidate will present an opening statement. It can last up to 10 minutes. The Moderator will time each Opening statement and signal to the speaking Candidate when 10 minutes is reached.
- 6. An open question period will follow. Algonquins whose names are on the Electoral List will be invited to ask Questions to the candidate (s).

Specifically:

- Questions will be directed to the Moderator in the zoom chat, who will call on the individual to state their name and then ask their question, in the order on chat.
- Questions must be brief and not a repetition of one already asked.
- The Moderator will direct the appropriate Candidate to reply to a directed question or all Candidates to answer a more general question.
- If one particular Candidate is asked a specific question, the other Candidate(s) will be offered a
 chance to comment if they wish by the Moderator after the first Candidate finishes their response.
- Candidates are asked to reply briefly to each question.
- The Moderator will vary the order in which candidates to reply to questions to be fair to all Candidates.
- If a Candidates would like to reply between an answer given by another Candidate, they will have one chance to respond.
- The Moderator will only allow questions which explore the ability of each of the Candidates in relation to the position they are to be elected to fill, that of Algonquin Negotiation Representative.
- 7. Candidates will give a 2-minute closing remark. The Moderator will time each Closing Statement and will signal to the speaking candidate when 2 minutes are up.
- 8. At 8:15 pm, if no one has any further questions, the Moderator will invite the Candidates to give their 2 minute Closing Statements.

The meeting would adjourn at 9:00 pm.

If there are further questions, and all Candidates approve an extension, the Moderator will allow the question period to extend to 9:30 pm, and then invite the Candidates to give their 2-minute closing statements.

The meeting will then adjourn at 9 pm unless otherwise extended.
