**Re: Anna McDonell & Cecile McDonell reports**

Kwey Algonquin Tribunal members,

We have combined the 2 reports as we believe that they are the same family. (Anna McDonell is the niece of Cecile McDonell, Cecile McDonell is the brother of Alexander McDonell and both Cecile and Alexander McDonell have the same parents Allan McDonell and Margaret Anne Cameron)

**Alexander McDonell:** Alexander McDonell was married in July 1837 and is listed as "Majeur" which means that he was 21 years or older (born prior to July 1816). We also know that Alexander entered the Hudson Bay Company on July 14, 1826. His father signed on his behalf meaning that he was 20 years or younger. (Born sometime after July 14, 1806) From his 1826 contract, most likely he was somewhere between 17 to 20 years old. **So Alexander would have been born somewhere between 1806 & 1809.**

**Cecile McDonell:** Cecile McDonell was married in June 1837 and is listed as "Majeur" which means that she was 21 years or older (born prior to June 1816) Cecile died in April 1875 at the age of 62 (born abt 1813)

1861 census Cecile is listed as 48 years old (born 1813) Also notice on the 1861 census record that Narcisse and his son are separately listed on the same page. Narcisse Sr is listed as 50 years on one (born 1801) and 55 (born 1806) on the other one and we know that Narcisse was born in 1807. 1871 census Cecile is listed as 64 years old (born 1807)

**From the above records, Cecile would have been born between 1807 and 1816. Joan's report says 1807-1813**

The reason to compare both Cecile and Alexander McDonell's ages are to show that Alexander and Cecile were both born at about the same time. Alexander could possibly be even a little bit older than Cecile.

**Margaret Anne Cameron:** The only place that Margaret Anne Cameron's age is recorded is on her death record. In Joan Homes' report, she indicated that Margaret Ann was 86 years old when she passed away. This is incorrect as it states that she was 96 years old "quatre vingt seize". 86

would have been written quatre vingt six. On the exact same page on the bottom by the same priest, he write 10 as "dix ans". Very clearly written.

Margaret Ann also had another daughter Sophie who married John Livingston on December 18, 1834. She was baptized on December 17, 1834 as an adult as she married the next day. If she was of age at her marriage (21) she would have been born around 1813 or before. Joan list her as born 1811.

**Margaret Anne was born in about 1789. This is consistent with all internet searches and with all the documents that were provided. We disagree that Margaret couldn't be the mother of Cecile due to her age. She was plenty old enough to be the mother for Alexander, Sophie and Cecile as well.**

**Connections between Alexander McDonell and Cecile McDonell:**

Anna McDonell was baptized on June 15, 1845 in Temiscaming and her godfather was her uncle Narcisse Dorion or Lorion who was married to Cecile McDonell.

Daniel Dorion was baptized on May 30, 1847 in Mattawa and his godmother was his aunt Marie Anne McKay who was married to Alexander McDonell.

Alexandre Dorion was baptized on September 27, 1849 in Mattawa and his godfather was his uncle Alexander McDonell.

Alfred McDonell was baptized on June 20, 1864 in Mattawa and his godmother was the father's cousin Marguerite Dorion, daughter of Narcisse and Cecile.

Allen McDonell was baptized on July 27, 1873 in Mattawa and his godparents were his uncle and aunt Narcisse Dorion & Cecile McDonell.

**It's clear of the connection between these 2 families are related. This is NOT just coincidence.**

We believe that Alexander McDonell and Cecile McDonell are full brother and sister.

**Alexander McDonell's 2 children Anna & Sophie are clearly listed as Algonquins, Cecile McDonell's daughter Caroline is listed as Indian on the 1881 census record, Marie Cecile as Indian on the 1881 census and Red on the 1901 census, Sophie is listed as Indian on the 1881 Census and Red on the 1901 census. Alexander McDonell is mentioned many times as a native will working with the Hudson Bay Company.**

I've attached documents for your reference.

This has been very hard on her family and would hope that this information will help with your deliberations.

## An Agreement

McDonell, Alex 1826 254

July \_\_\_\_\_ made this fourteenth — day of  
 in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and  
 Twenty six <sup>26</sup>  
 BETWEEN Allan McDonell Esq. & now of York Factory  
 master Servant of for his son Alexander in the County of St. Donell —  
 in North America, of the one part, and The Governor and Company of  
 Adventurers of England Trading into Hudson's Bay, by George —  
 Simpson Esq. Governor their Agent of the other part as follows:

The said Alexander McDonell with the <sup>consent of his father</sup> hereby contracts and agrees to enter into the service and Employment of the said Company in North America in the capacity of Apprentice Labourer and that he will embark when thereunto required, on board such ship or Vessel as shall be appointed by the said Company, and proceed to Hudson's Bay and the Term of five Years to be completed from the said Embarkation, and for such further time as heretofore mentioned and faithfully serve the said Company as their hired Servant in the capacity of Apprentice Labourer <sup>and</sup> devote the whole of his time and labour in their service and for their sole benefit, and that he will do his duty as such and perform all such Work and service, by day or by night, for the said Company as he shall be required to do, and obey all orders, which he shall receive from the Governor of the Company in North America, or other their Officers or Agents for the time being. And that he will with courage and fidelity in his said service, defend the property of the said Company and their Factors and Servitors. And will not absent himself from the said Service, nor engage or be concerned in any Trade or Employment whatsoever except for the benefit of the said Company and according to their orders. And that all Goods obtained by him with the Industry or Strength which shall come to the hands or possession of the said Alexander McDonell — shall be held by him for the said Company only, and shall be duly delivered up to the said Governor or other Officer at their Factory or Trading Post, without any waste, spoil or injury thereto. And in case of any wilful neglect or default herein, he shall make good to the said Company all such loss or damage as they shall sustain thereby, to be deducted out of his wages. And that the said Alexander McDonell — will faithfully obey all Laws, Orders and Regulations established or made by the said Company for the good Government of their Settlements and Territories. And at all times during the existence of the said Alexander McDonell — in North America he will defend the Rights and Privileges of the said Company and aid and support their Officers and Agents to the utmost of his power. And the said Alexander McDonell further engages and agrees, that in case he should come to Europe, the Governor or Officers of the said Company in North America one year or afterwards before the expiration of the said term of five Years of his entering to quit their Service and return to Europe, then that he hereby promises and engages to remain one year longer, and also until the next ship in the service of the said Company shall sail from thence for Europe, as their hired Servant in North America, upon the like terms as are contained in this contract, and the said Alexander McDonell — also engages and agrees that in case the said Company shall not have any ship which will sail from Hudson's Bay for Europe immediately after the expiration of the said term of five Years, or of such further time as herefore mentioned, then he hereby promises and engages to remain in the service as a hired Servant of the said Company in North America until the next ship of the said Company shall sail from thence for Europe upon the like terms as are contained in this contract. And the said George Simpson — on behalf of the said Company hereby engages that upon conclusion of the due and faithful service of the said Alexander McDonell — in like manner as aforesaid, but not otherwise the said Alexander McDonell — shall receive from the said Company after the rate of Ten Pounds Sterling per annum, the three first years of this Agreement and the two last years Fifteen Pounds Sterling.

for Hudson's Bay as aforesaid, and up to the day of his Embarkation from thence for Europe in one of the Ships of the said Company's Service. Provided always and it is hereby expressly agreed between the said Parties hereto, that it shall be lawful for the Governor or Governor or other Officers of the said Company in North America at any time during the said Term of five Years, or such additional Term as aforesaid to dismiss the said Alexander McDonell — from their Service and discharge his return from thence to Europe, in one of the ships in their Employment, and in such case his Wages are to cease from the day of his embarkation for Europe, and further that in case the said Alexander McDonell — shall at any time during this contract desert the service of the said Company, or otherwise neglect or refuse duty to discharge his duty as said hired Servant as aforesaid, then he shall forfeit and lose all his Wages for the recovery whereof there shall be no relief either in Law or in Equity. In witness whereof the said Parties have hereunto set their hands.
