Thank you in advance for your consideration.

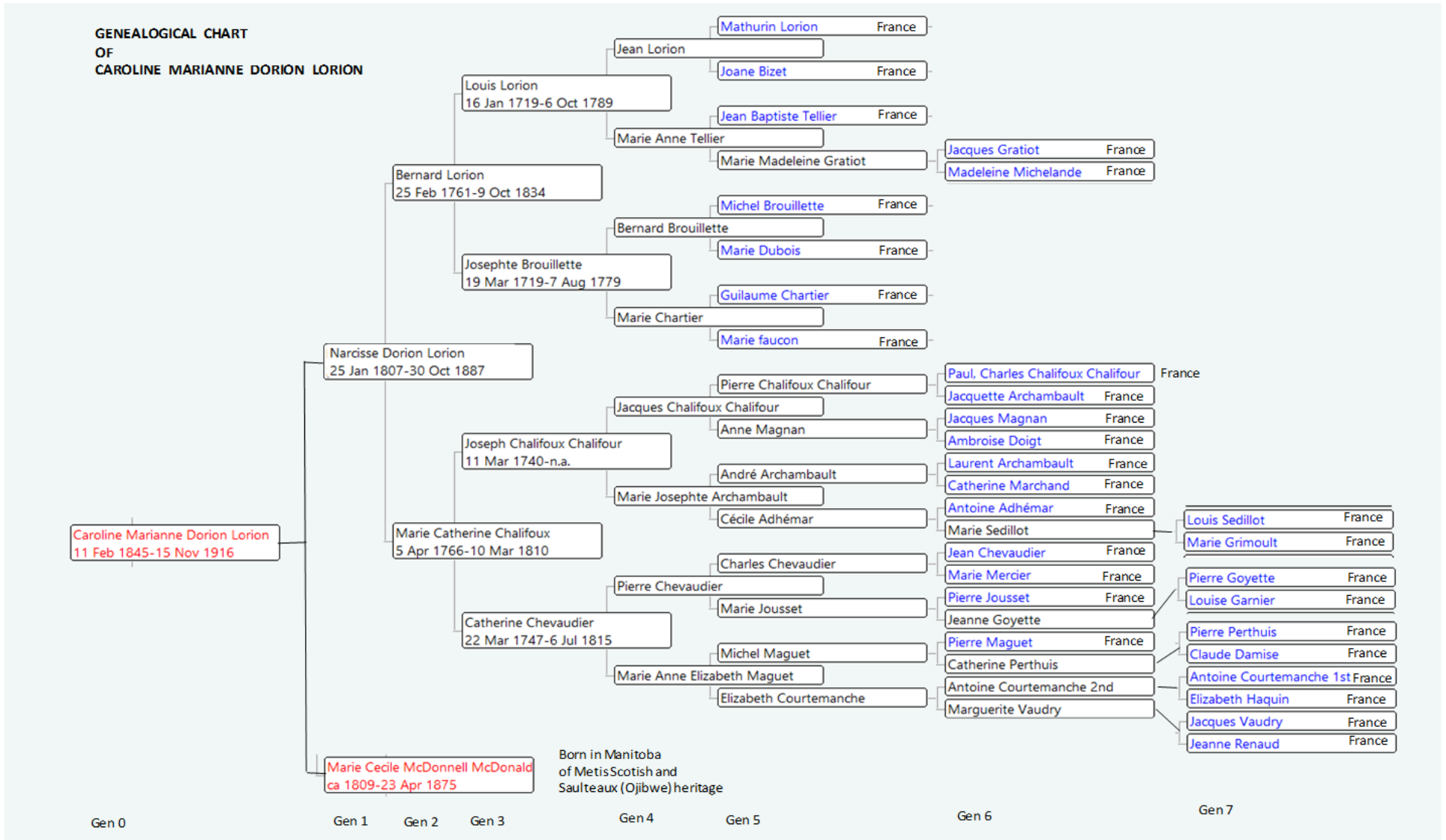

METIS / SAULTEAUX (OJIBWE) ORIGINS OF MARIE CECILE MCDONNELL DITE MAWISKAK AND HER DAUGHTER CAROLINE MARIANNE DORION

01. Introduction

The Algonquins of Ontario (AOO) are on a journey of survival, rebuilding and self-sufficiency – a journey of reconciliation. This journey began nearly 250 years ago when the first Algonquin Petition was submitted to the Crown in 1772.

Algonquins have lived in present-day Ontario for thousands of years before Europeans arrived. Today, the AOO are comprised of ten (10) Algonquin communities. These include:

- Antoine
- Algonquins of Pikwakanagan First Nation
- Bonnechere
- Greater Golden Lake
- Kijicho Manito Madaouskarini (Bancroft)
- Mattawa/North Bay
- Ottawa
- Shabot Obaadjiwan (Sharbot Lake)
- Snimikobi (Ardoch)
- Whitney and Area

The ten (10) communities are represented by sixteen (16) Algonquin Negotiation Representatives (ANRs) who are elected by Algonquin Voters for three-year terms. The ANRs include the Chief and Council of the Algonquins of Pikwakanagan First Nation and one (1) representative from each of the nine (9) other Algonquin communities.

Based on a Protocol signed in 2004, these communities are working together to provide a unified approach to reach a settlement of the Algonquin land claim.

The Algonquins of Ontario claim includes an area of 9 million acres within the watersheds of the Kichi Sippi (Ottawa River) and the Mattawa River in Ontario, an unceded territory that covers most of eastern Ontario. More than 1.2 million people live and work within the Settlement Area. There are 84 municipal jurisdictions fully and partially located within the Settlement Area, including 75 lower and single tier municipalities and 9 upper tier counties.

Today's Algonquins in Ontario share a history of common interests, traditions and needs arising from their common heritage. (See <https://www.tanakiwin.com/>)

02. Proposed Algonquins of Ontario Enrolment Criteria

After extensive deliberation and consultation with their constituents over the past several years, the Algonquin Negotiation Representatives have approved by Special Resolution as at 2020-01-22 a proposed new set of Beneficiary Criteria which replaces the one that was approved in the 2016 Agreement in Principle.

As per the previous set of criteria, all members of the *Algonquins of Pikwakanagan First Nation* who are “Status Indians” under the Indian Act are automatically included as citizens and beneficiaries of the AOO and need not meet any other enrolment criteria.

However, all other Algonquins who are “Non-Status” must meet specific exclusive criteria to be enrolled as voters and citizens of the Algonquin of Ontario and as Aboriginal rights holders of the AOO treaty.

The very first fundamental criteria to be met by applicants is to demonstrate a *direct lineal descent* from an Algonquin or Nipissing root ancestor as recognized by the Algonquins of Ontario in its Schedule of Ancestors.

The most recent AOO Schedule of Ancestors is dated 2020-01-22 and was posted publicly on the Algonquins of Ontario web site sometime in July 2021.

It was utilized to enrol voters for the 2021 ANR elections.

03. AOO Root Ancestors Marie Cecile McDonnell-dite Mawiskak and Caroline Marianne Dorion

The previous publicly available AOO Schedule of Ancestors (2013) contained the names of many individuals whose Algonquin or Nipissing origins are not based on any genealogical analysis but rather on their descendants’ oral family histories of being Algonquin as supported by circumstantial evidence they provided to the AOO.

This Schedule included many root ancestors whose Algonquin origins were controversial and many of whom are still on the current 2020-01-22 Schedule of Ancestors such as:

- Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak
- Caroline Marianne Dorion

As per information shown on the 2013 Schedule of Ancestors (Annexes A-1 and B-1), it seems that *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and her daughter *Caroline Marianne Dorion* were first recognized as Algonquin Root Ancestors and included on 2000-04-15 in the AOO Schedule of Ancestors.

Their inclusions on the list were both contested eleven (11) years later in 2011. However, the AOO Enrolment Review Committee, for whatever reason, dismissed the protests.

Consequently, both mother and daughter remained on the Schedule of Ancestors as Algonquin or Nipissing ancestors for the purposes of enrolment with the Algonquin of Ontario and the establishment of the 2016 AIP voters list.

Their names are still currently listed as AOO Root Ancestors on the current 2020-01-22 Schedule of Ancestors for the purposes of Phase 1 of the enrolment process with the Algonquin of Ontario and the establishment of the 2021 ANR voters list. (Annexes A-2 and B-2)

04. Origins of Marie Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak and her daughter Caroline Marianne Dorion

A simple search for either *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and/or her daughter *Caroline Marianne Dorion* on Google reveals that their genealogy is well known and is available for review and research on the Internet for anybody interested in their origins including the AOO and especially her descendants who claim that they are of Algonquin origins for the purposes, amongst other things, of their enrolment with the Algonquins of Ontario.

In effect, their genealogies and much more information regarding them, their ancestors and their descendants can be found at the following free public internet sites:

It should be noted that both the *Metis National Council (MCN)* and the *Algonquins of Ontario (AOO)* do not recognize the *Metis Nation of Ontario Mattawa/Ottawa River Metis Community* and/or the *Metis Nation of Canada* as legitimate Metis organizations.

Nonetheless, both *Caroline Marianne Dorion* and *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak's* names appear on the root ancestors' lists of both the *Metis Nation of Ontario*, the *Metis Nation of Canada* and also of the *Algonquins of Ontario First Nation*.

Of particular note, the Metis Nation of Ontario has established that Caroline Marianne Dorion's parents, Narcisse Dorion and Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak are the Metis Root Ancestors of the Dorion-McDonnell metis family and that all their descendants who identify as Metis are recognized citizens of their MNO Historic Métis Community of Mattawa/Ottawa River.

In Canada, the Inuit, Metis and First Nation peoples are considered as separate and very distinct indigenous Nations.

While a root ancestor only needs to demonstrate being of mixed Indigenous-European heritage and of having been involved in the North-West fur trade in what is considered as the '*Historic Metis Homeland*' as defined by the MNC to be recognized as a Metis, an AOO root ancestor is defined as "*a person who was born on or before July 15, 1897, and identified in an historic record or document dated on or before December 31, 1911, in such a way that it would be reasonable to conclude that the person was considered to be an Algonquin or Nipissing, or a full sibling of such a person.*"

This said, a review of the above mentioned three (3) independent individual genealogical studies found on the internet and their supporting documents shows that while both these root ancestors have been identified several times in censuses and other documents as being “Indians” or “Metis”, no historic documents whatsoever have been found so far that would explicitly state and thus confirm that *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and/or her daughter *Caroline Marianne Dorion* were of Algonquin or Nipissing First Nation origins. None.

Thus it appears that *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and her daughter *Caroline Marianne Dorion* “Algonquin” identities as AOO Root Ancestors were strictly based on circumstantial evidence submitted by those of their descendants who identify as **Algonquin** and not as Metis and which were most likely based on their family purported oral history of being of “Algonquin” descent, their being identified in various historic documents as being “Indians” or “Metis” and, of course, their residing in Algonquin Territory in the Mattawa area.

However, circumstantial evidence such as having an unsubstantiated family history of being of Algonquin descent and/or being identified as being an Indian and/or living in Algonquin territory, etc... does not prove by themselves that a person is of Algonquin heritage.

Without the benefit of a thorough genealogical analysis of *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and her daughter *Caroline Marianne Dorion's* Algonquin ancestry and/or a historic document explicitly stating their Algonquin or Nipissing identity, their Algonquin identity can only be **surmised** which means “*supposed to be true without having evidence to confirm it*” or, at best, **inferred** which means “*deduced to be true from circumstantial evidence and reasoning rather than from explicit statements.*”

Revealing the **Truth** (i.e. Nin Tebwe) about *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and her daughter *Caroline Marianne Dorion's* true origins and resolving this Riddle as a researcher would require a far richer much more detailed set of information than what was surely provided to the Algonquins of Ontario by their descendants in support of their claim that they were of Algonquin origins or, even for that matter, to the Metis Nation of Ontario that they were, instead, Metis.

05. A Genealogy is the surest and most reliable way to determine a person's true origins

Genealogy is the study of an individual's family, their family history and the tracing of their lineages and ancestors in both time and space. Genealogists use oral interviews, historical records, genetic DNA analysis, and other records to obtain information about an individual and their family and to demonstrate kinship and pedigrees of its members and their origins.

While DNA analysis is scientifically proven to be extremely precise in identifying a person in forensic and/or paternity/maternity cases, it is absolutely unreliable in determining with any precision if a person is Algonquin or not and much less identifying exactly who their Algonquin or Nipissing ancestor was in both time and space. In addition, given that a person only inherits at random 50% of their parents' genes at each generation, so called “Indigenous” DNA genes may be present in some members of a family but completely absent in others. For all these reasons, DNA analysis for the purposes of genealogy and enrolment with any Indigenous Nation including the Algonquins of Ontario is not recommended. Unless used in forensic or paternity/maternity cases to establish identity and/or relationships between known Algonquin individuals in time and space, DNA tests cannot be used as a substitute for a genealogy prepared in accordance to standards.

Unless revealed in a historic record and/or determined through modern DNA testing, genealogy will not be able to determine if a given ancestor was the result of a hidden adoption or of a misattributed paternity fraud perpetuated by a woman against her husband in cases of adultery.

As defined by the Board for Certification of Genealogists (USA), Genealogical Proof Standards consist of five (5) elements:

- 1) A reasonably exhaustive search for all pertinent information;
- 2) A complete and accurate citation to the source of each item used;
- 3) Analysis of the collected information's quality as evidence;
- 4) Resolution of any conflicting or contradictory evidence;
- 5) Arrive at a soundly reasoned, coherently written conclusion.

While genealogy may not be 100% accurate, it is as close to accurate as can be attained given the information and sources presently available on any given person and their ancestors.

A completed genealogy using original source, primary information and direct evidence historic records and a genealogical conclusion that meets these standards can be considered as proved.

Providing a person's genealogy strictly based on *original source*, *primary information* and *direct evidence* historic records such as birth, marriage and/or sepulture (BMS) records in both time and space and strictly following *Genealogical Proof Standards* remains the surest and most reliable method and approach to unequivocally prove with a very high degree of confidence a person Algonquin or Nipissing heritage beyond any reasonable doubt for enrolment and/or any other reasons.

Conclusions reached which meet the five (5) elements of the Genealogical Proof Standard will generally continue to hold as true, even if new evidence is uncovered.

06. Metis and Scottish /Manitoba Saulteaux origins of Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak

Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak genealogy unfortunately could not be completed given that her parents' names are unknown.

However, original source, primary information and direct evidence historic records have been traced in Church records and in public archives that unequivocally clearly *states* that she is *Metis* being of mixed Scottish and Manitoba Saulteaux (i.e. Ojibwe) First Nation origins whose family was directly involved as employees of the Hudson's Bay Company and who were posted at its various locations.

Thus we have:

- a) On 1837-06-22 in Mattawa, Ontario, Narcise Laurion (aka Narcise Dorion Lorion) of major age, employee of the Hudson's Bay Company's Mattawan Post married Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak, a major baptized *Metisse* residing at the said HBC post. (Annex C)
- b) 1871 Census for Mattawa-North shows that Cecile Dorion (i.e. Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak) wife of Narcis Dorion was enumerated along with her husband and children. She is said to be 64 years old, born in *Manitoba* and of *Scottish* origins. (Annex D)

It is to be noted that Manitoba is Ojibwe (i.e. Saulteaux), Cree, Oji-Cree, Dene and Metis Traditional Territory and not of the Algonquin Nation whose traditional territory instead is situated far away in the Kitci Sipi (i.e. Ottawa River) watershed in Ontario and Québec.

The Saulteaux, otherwise known as the Plains Ojibwe, are First Nations Indigenous peoples found today in Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia, Canada. They are a branch of the Ojibwe Nation who were pushed West because of colonialism.

- c) On 1836-07-09, in Mattawa, Ontario was baptised Narcis Dorion, aged three (3) months old, son of Narcis Dorion, caretaker of the said (Mattawan) HBC post and of Cecile Mawiskak of the *Saulteaux* (i.e. Ojibwe) Nation. (Annex E)
- d) 1891 census for Mattawa, Caroline Marianne Dorion's father, Narcisse Dorion Lorion, was shown as having been born in Québec while her mother, Cecile McDonnell, was born in Manitoba. (Annex I),

From the above noted four (4) historic records and *explicit statements*, it is unequivocally clear that *Marie Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak* was born in Manitoba. She was identified as being a Metis of mixed *Scottish* and *Saulteaux* (i.e. Ojibwe) origins whose life and livelihood revolved around the Hudson's Bay Company fur trading activities including the Mattawan Post in Algonquin Territory in Ontario.

As a result, having on hand *explicit statements* about her true origins, neither her descendants nor the Algonquins of Ontario nor anybody else for that matter need continue surmising and/or inferring or giving her the benefit of the doubt in regards to her so called "Algonquin" indigenous origins.

Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak is simply not of Algonquin or Nipissing descent. She was born in Manitoba, homeland of the Saulteaux (i.e. Ojibwe) Nation. She is a Metis woman of mixed Scottish and Manitoba Saulteaux (Ojibwe) origins and part of the greater Metis Nation whose citizens' lives and livelihood revolved around the various Hudson's Bay Company's fur trading posts in the North-West.

As such, the *Metis Nation of Ontario* considers her to be one of their Metis Root Ancestors.

07. Metis French/Scottish/Saulteaux (i.e. Ojibwe) origins of Caroline Marianne Dorion

Caroline Marianne Dorion, *baptized* as Marianne Lorion on 1845-06-08 in Maniwaki, Québec, was *born* on 1845-02-15 at an unknown location from the lawful marriage of Narcise Lorion and Cecile McDonnell. (Annex F)

During her lifetime, she interchangeably used the names Marianne and/or Caroline Lorion or Dorion at various events including censuses and the baptism and/or marriages of her children.

In effect, on 1864-08-06 in Mattawa, Ontario, she married Joseph Lapensée as Caroline Dorion. Her parents' names were given as Narcise Dorion and Cecile Mc Donnell. (Annex G)

In the 1881 census for Renfrew North, Ontario, she was enumerated with her husband Joseph Lapensée as Caroline Lapensée (née Dorion) along with their children. She is listed as being 35 years old (DOB 1846), born in Québec and an *Indian*. Her husband is listed as French while their children are shown as French Half-Breed which words were subsequently crossed-out and replaced by the word "French". (Annex H)

METIS / SAULTEAUX (OJIBWE) ORIGINS OF MARIE CECILE MCDONNELL DITE MAWISKAK AND HER DAUGHTER CAROLINE MARIANNE DORION

In the 1891 census for Mattawa, Ontario, she was again enumerated under the name Caroline Lapensée and as being 45 years old (DOB 1846) but born in Ontario. While her husband and children are listed as being French Canadian, she is not listed as such. (Annex I)

It is to be noted that the 1891 census shows that her father was born in Québec while her mother, Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak, was born in *Manitoba* thus confirming her mother's Manitoba origins. (Annex I)

Widowed on 1883-09-23, Caroline Marianne Dorion later married Louis Sirois under the name of *Marie Anne Dorion* in Mattawa, Ontario, on 1885-10-26. Her late husband's name was clearly identified as being Joe Lapensée. (Annex J)

In the 1901 census for Temiskaming, Pontiac, Québec, Caroline Marianne Dorion was enumerated with her second husband Louis Sirois under the name of Marie Anna Sirois. (Annex K)

She is said to have been born on 1842-07-13 in the province of Québec. Both she and her husband are said to be "White" and of French origins. They are living next door to her son France Lapensée, his wife Clothilde, her other son Delphis Lapensée and a lodger, Calixte Taillefer.

Caroline Marianne Dorion passed away on 1916-11-15 in Mattawa, Ontario under the name of Caroline Dorion. Her husband's name is clearly indicated as being Louis Sirois. (Annex L)

Since her mother, Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak, has been proven not to be of Algonquin or Nipissing descent but rather a Metis woman of mixed Scottish and Manitoba Saulteaux (Ojibwe) origins, Caroline Marianne Dorion's Algonquin heritage, if any, would have had to come from her father, Narcisse Dorion Lorion Laurion and not from her mother.

This said, it then becomes obvious that to confirm that Caroline Marianne Dorion's Algonquin identity originates from her father's side, his genealogy must be done to identify which of his ancestors, if any, was indeed Algonquin or Nipissing.

08. Genealogy and French Origins of Narcisse Dorion Lorion Laurion

While the names of Narcisse Dorion Lorion Laurion's parents were not mentioned in his 1837 marriage record to Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak, his parents identity can be confirmed based on various circumstantial evidence, historic documents and explicit statements.

The Hudson's Bay Company Servant's Register shows that three (3) individuals with the surname "Laurion" was employed at various posts during the 1830s. (Annex M)

Starting in 1830, we have a person named Narcisse Laurion working for the HBC followed in 1835 by Charles Laurion and Louis Laurion all of whom are from the small parish of Pointe-aux-Trembles, Québec. (Annex M)

Confirming that the person named Narcisse Laurion mentioned in the 1837 marriage record in Mattawa is the same person employed by the HBC in 1830, his HBC employment record shows that he was posted during the period 1830 to 1833 at Norway House, Manitoba. (Annex N)

**METIS / SAULTEAUX (OJIBWE) ORIGINS OF
MARIE CECILE MCDONNELL DITE MAWISKAK AND HER DAUGHTER
CAROLINE MARIANNE DORION**

At the end of his initial three (3) years contract, he would have then taken a leave of absence in 1834 for Montreal (i.e. Pointe-Aux-Trembles) only to return back to the HBC in 1835 and posted at Mattawan.

At that time in 1835, he would have recruited it seems this time around two (2) of his brothers, Charles and Louis Laurion, to also work as voyageurs like him for the HBC.

During the period 1835 to 1837, the HBC Record shows that Narcisse Lorion was posted at Mattawa, Ontario, where, in 1837, he married Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak. For the period 1837 to 1840, he was posted at Lac des Allumettes, on the Ottawa River near Petawawa and Renfrew, Ontario. (Annex N)

His marriage to Cecile McDonnell in 1837 in Mattawa mentions that he was previously married to her in a “civil contract” and that his first child, Mary Lorion, was born on 1834-01-16 and his second child, Narcis Jr. Lorion was born around 1836-03-09.

Given that Cecile was a Metis of mixed Scottish and Saulteaux origins and born in Manitoba, it can be reasonably inferred from Narcisse’s employment record that he would have met and married his wife Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak, by a “civil contract”, during his travels in Manitoba sometime between 1830 and 1833 when he was posted at Norway House, Manitoba.

Consequently, his daughter, Mary, was most likely born on 1834-01-16 while the couple was still in Norway House, Manitoba, just prior to their leaving for Montreal (i.e. Pointe-aux-Trembles). It is presumed that his wife and child travelled with him to Pointe-aux-Trembles in 1834 to meet his parents.

His son, Narcise Jr., who was baptized on 1836-07-09 in Maniwaki, Québec, then aged three (3) months old was most likely born in Mattawa, Ontario where his father, Narcise Sr, was posted with his wife, Cecile, at the time as per HBC record

A review of the University of Montreal PRDH Genealogy Data Base covering the fifty (50) years period 1780 to 1830 shows that of the eleven (11) persons born during that period and named “Narcisse Lorion”, only one (1) is listed as being from the parish of Pointe-aux-Trembles, Québec. (Annex O)

That person was born on 1807-01-25 in Pointe-aux-Trembles, Québec, and is the son of Bernard Lorion and Marie Catherine Chalifoux. (Annex P.)

Further confirming well beyond a reasonable doubt that this Narcisse Laurion, the son of Bernard Lorion, and Catherine Chalifour is indeed the same person who was a HBC employee and was married to Cecile McDonnell in Mattawa is the fact that the records also shows that he had two (2) brothers whose names were Charles and Louis Laurion and whose names and parish correspond to the very same two (2) individuals mentioned previously who started working in 1835 with the HBC when Narcisse re-enrolled. (Annex P)

Having thus identified well beyond a reasonable doubt Narcisse Dorion Lorion Laurion parents as being Bernard Lorion and Marie Catherine Chalifour, his genealogy can then be completed with a high degree of confidence and in accordance to Genealogical Proof Standards.

METIS / SAULTEAUX (OJIBWE) ORIGINS OF MARIE CECILE MCDONNELL DITE MAWISKAK AND HER DAUGHTER CAROLINE MARIANNE DORION

Given the importance to the Algonquins of Ontario and especially to the families involved who rely solely on Caroline Marianne Dorion as an Algonquin root ancestor for their enrolment with the AOO, *Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion* complete genealogy was done going back in time and space six (6) generations to the beginning of New France and which comprises 58 ancestors. (See Genealogical Chart; Ahnentafel Listing of Ancestors and Generations Nos. 1 to 7).

Strictly using the University of Montreal Demography Dept. PRDH-IGD indexed genealogy data base and records supported by photographic images of original historic documents contained in Church Registries which are all publicly available for viewing at the National Archives of Quebec and/or Ancestry and/or Family Search web sites, *Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion* complete patrilineal and matrilineal genealogy clearly unequivocally proves that he is a settler of European descent and in particular of **French** origins. To be clear, he is not of Algonquin or Nipissing descent.

09. Summary of Findings on the origins of Cecile McDonnell and Caroline Marianne Dorion

There is no longer any need for any of *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak* and *Caroline Marianne Dorion's* descendants, the Algonquins of Ontario and/or anybody else for that matter to surmise or infer and/or be given the benefit of the doubt that these two (2) root ancestors are of Algonquin origins.

They are simply not of Algonquin or Nipissing origins.

In summary, they are not of Algonquin or Nipissing origins due to the facts that:

- 1) Historic records and explicit statements have been found that unequivocally state that *Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak, Caroline Marianne Dorion's* mother, was a Metis of mixed Scottish and Manitoba born Saulteaux (Ojibwe) origins and not Algonquin; and
- 2) A complete genealogy in time and space to the beginning of New France prepared in accordance to Genealogical Proof Standards unequivocally demonstrates that Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak's husband and Caroline Marianne Dorion's father, *Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion*, based on his genealogy, is exclusively of French ancestry and is not Algonquin.

As such, the **Metis Nation of Ontario** considers both women to be Metis Root Ancestors not Algonquin.

10. Conclusion

WHEREAS Marie Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak and her daughter Caroline Marianne Dorion were listed as Algonquin root ancestors in the October 2013 AOO Schedule of Ancestors (Annex A-1 and B-1) and are still listed in the current 2020 Schedule (Annex A-2 and B-2);

WHEREAS while Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak parents are unknown, her identity nonetheless has been confirmed in various historic records and explicit statements as being a Metis of mixed Scottish and Manitoba born Saulteaux (Ojibwe) origin and not Algonquin or Nipissing.

WHEREAS it was determined beyond a shadow of a doubt that Cecile McDonnell Mawiskak's husband and Caroline Marianne Dorion's father, *Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's* was born on 1807-01-25 in Pointe aux Trembles, Québec, and that his parents were Bernard Lorion and Marie Catherine Chalifour;

WHEREAS the University of Montreal PRDH genealogy data base shows that Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's and his ancestors are exclusively of French origins;

WHEREAS an independent genealogy of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's genealogy has been posted on the Généalogie du Québec et d'Amérique française web site and also shows that he and his ancestors are exclusively of French origins;

WHEREAS a Genealogy of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion and all his ancestors recorded in Canada was completed in conformity with Genealogical Proof Standards and are fully supported by original source, primary information and direct evidence historic documents;

WHEREAS a reasonably exhaustive search for all pertinent information in time and space regarding each and every one of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's ancestors, both patrilineal and matrilineal, was completed right up to their first recorded original source, primary information and direct evidence baptism and/or marriage and/or sepulture (BMS) historic record as registered in Canada and as supported by a Genealogical Chart and Ahnentafel List;

WHEREAS every individual ancestor named in a BMS historic record was clearly identified as being one of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's direct ancestor and was linked to the previous generation to their own parents using information contained in photographic images of original source, primary information and direct evidence baptism and/or marriage and/or sepulture (BMS) historic records obtained in Ancestry and Family Search genealogical data bases;

WHEREAS every individual ancestor named in a BMS historic record clearly identified as being one of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion and his siblings direct ancestor had a **French** name and originated from a region situated outside the Algonquin traditional homeland and their origins were traced in space and time back to Europe and in particular France.

WHEREAS, to ensure quality control, all information contained in photographic images of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's and his ancestors original birth, marriage and sepulture historic records were compared whenever possible with the University of Montreal, "*Progranme de Recherche Démographique Historique*" (PRDH) data base and with each individual ancestor's corresponding PRDH genealogy certificate;

WHEREAS any conflicting or contradictory evidence found between the original historic record and the PRDH certificate was identified and/or resolved.

WHEREAS no missing links were found and there is no indication that any of Narcise Dorion Lorion Laurion's ancestors were adopted and/or were the result of a misattributed paternity and/or was born of unknown parents,

WHEREAS copies of each and every original source historic record are provided and a complete and accurate citation and link to the original source of each item used as evidence and as supporting documents were duly noted and provided for purposes of verification and authenticity;

IT IS HEREBY CONCLUDED that Cecile McDonnell dite Mawiskak and her daughter Caroline Marianne Dorion are not Algonquin or Nipissing but instead are both Metis being of mixed French/Scottish/Saulteaux (Ojibwe) heritage whose lives and livelihood resolved around the fur trading activities of the Hudson Bay's Company in Canada including the Mattawa HBC Post in Ontario.

Annex M : Hudson's Bay Servants' Engagement for Narcisse, Charles and Louis Laurion

As indicated in the Hudson's Bay Servants' Engagement Registers (1823-1895), Narcisse Laurion was engaged by the HBC in 1830. (for a 3 year contract, 1830-1833).

It is to be noted that Narcisse Lorion's wo (2) brothers, Charles and Louis Laurion were both engaged in 1835 by the HBC when Narcisse, after having taken the year 1834 off in Montreal (i.e. Pointe-aux-Trembles), signed up again with the HBC and was posted in Mattawa (See Annex M).

All three (3) are sons of Bernard Lorion and Marie Catherine Chalifoux (See Generation 1 , Individuals No. 2 and 4 along with PRDH family record).

Annex N: Hudson's Bay Company Archives, Biographical Sheet: Narcisse Laurion

As indicated in the Hudson's Bay Company Archives, Biographical Sheet, Narcisse Laurion is from the parish of Pointe-aux-Trembles, Québec.

He signed a three (3) year contract for the period 1830 to 1833 and was posted at Norway House, Manitoba, as a middleman.

A "Middleman" is a crewman in the middle of a boat or canoe and/or an unskilled position (often used interchangeably with 'labourer').

His marriage to Cecile McDonnell in 1837 mentions that he was previously married to her in a "civil contract" and that his first child, Mary Lorion, was born on 1834-01-16 and his second child, Narcis Jr. Lorion was born around 1836-03-09.

Given that Cecile was a Metis of mixed Scottish and Saulteaux origins and born in Manitoba, it can be reasonably inferred that Narcisse met his wife during his travels when he was posted at Norway House, Manitoba. Consequently, his daughter Mary who was born on 1834-01-16 most likely was born in Norway House, Manitoba. His son, Narcise Jr., who was baptized on 1836-07-09 in Maniwaki, Québec, then aged three (3) months old could have been born in Mattawa, Ontario where his father, Narcise Sr, was posted at the time as per HBC records.

It is to be noted that when his 1830 to 1833 contract was over in 1834, he returned to Pointe aux Trembles (Montréal). It is presumed that his wife and child travelled with him to meet his parents. However, he signed up again in 1835 with the HBC and recruited his brothers Charles and Louis to work for the HBC.

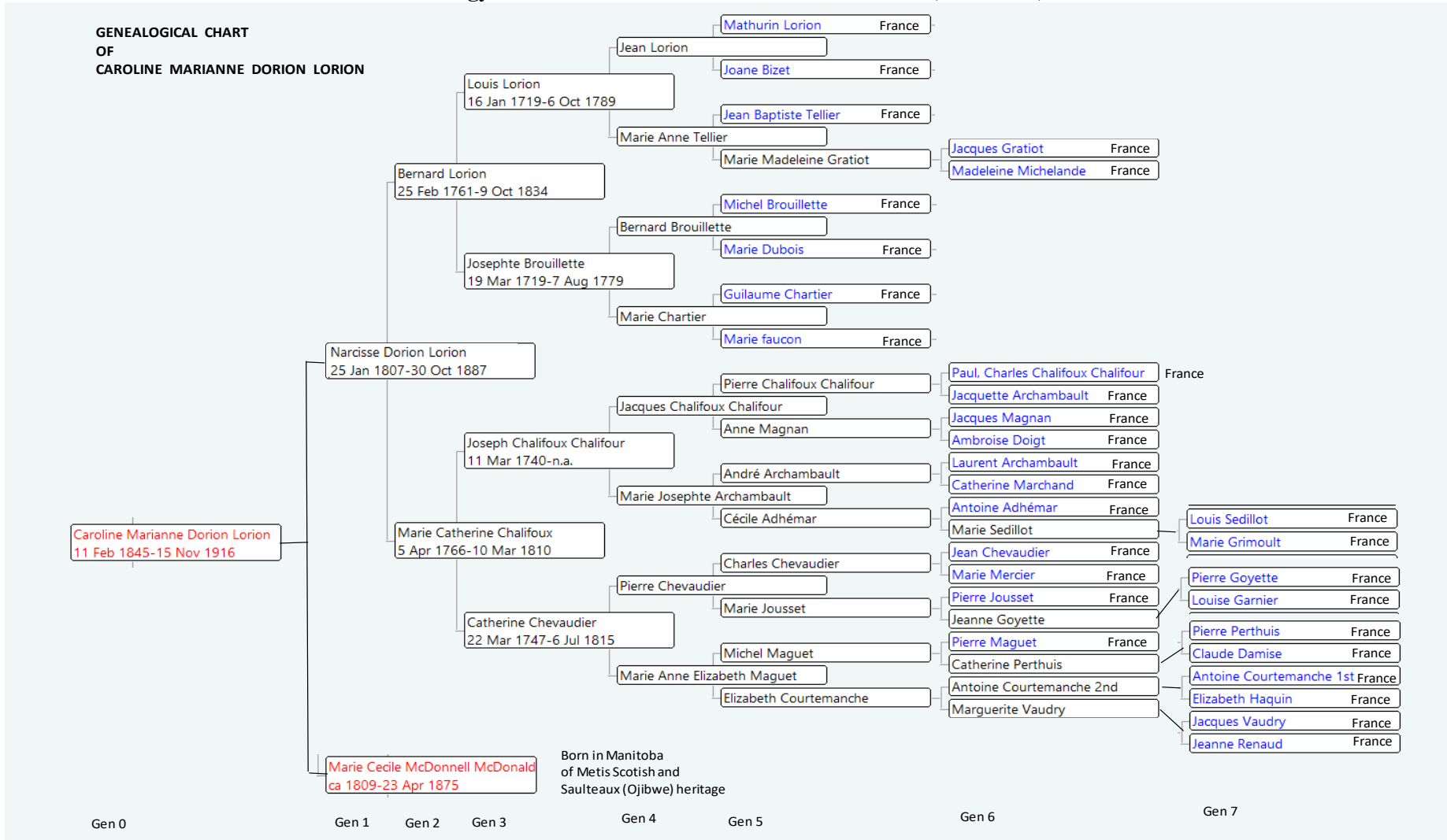

Ahnentafel Listing of Ancestors of Caroline Marianne Dorion Lorion

An ahnentafel list (German for "ancestor table") is a genealogical numbering system for listing a person's direct ancestors in a fixed sequence of ascent. The subject of the ahnentafel is listed as No. 1, the subject's father as No. 2 and the mother as No. 3, the paternal grandparents as No. 4 and No. 5 and the maternal grandparents as No. 6 and No. 7, and so on, back through the generations. Apart from No. 1, who can be male or female, all even-numbered persons are male, and all odd-numbered persons are female.

In this schema, the number of any person's father is double the person's number, and a person's mother is double the person's number plus one. Using this definition of numeration, one can easily trace the parents of individuals from one generation to the next without the need of a Genealogical Chart and/or additional research.

Consequently, at Generation 0, Caroline Marianne Dorion Lorion is No. 1 and at Generation 1, her father Narcisse Dorion Lorion is No. 2 (i.e. 1×2) and her mother Marie Cecile McDonnell McDonald is No. 3 (i.e. $2 + 1$) and so forth for all of her known ancestors recorded in Canada in Church registries at each generation in time and space to the very beginning of New France.

Generation 0

Genealogical Supporting documents were obtained from the following reliable sources :

- Ancestry.ca: Original source, primary information and direct evidence church record images and/or derivative summary transcripts of the original primary information and direct evidence record provided by *Ancestry* on a paid subscription basis.
- Family Search: Original source, primary information and direct evidence church record images and/or derivative summary transcripts of the original primary information and direct evidence record provided by *The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints* as a free public service; and/or
- PRDH: The *University of Montreal*, “*Progranme de Recheche Démographique Historique*” (PRDH) data base includes some 2,400, 000 certificates of various types, dated from the beginning of New France in 1621 right up to and including the year 1849 which are derived from primary information and direct evidence records.

The vast majority of these certificates, as certified by expert genealogists, archivists and historians, are derivative source documents which, by their definition, are records which have been derived—copied, abstracted, transcribed, or summarized—from previously existing original sources. As such, they correspond to the systematic extracting of information from *original, primary information* and *direct evidence* historic baptisms, marriages, and sepultures (BMS) records that came from the parishes, missions, and Catholic institutions in Quebec that kept registers prior to 1850.

It is to be noted that each ancestor’s name recorded in the PRDH is indexed to their children and their parents from one generation to the next to the very beginning of New France.

Furthermore, a PRDH record provides genealogist with the necessary information to easily trace the original source, primary information and direct evidence historic BMS church record to its church registry, archives or depository using the photographic images in Ancestry, Family Search, etc. data bases.

RDH service is provided on a paid subscription basis.

For each ancestor, derivative source support documents such as PRDH which are based on original source, primary information and direct evidence historic baptisms and/or marriages, and/or sepultures (BMS) records are presented first for each individual couple and/or individual mentioned at each generation.

These derivative source records are then followed by photographic images of original source, primary information and direct evidence historic baptisms and/or marriages and/or sepultures (BMS) records as found in Church registries for each individual at each generation and obtained from genealogical data bases such as Ancestry and/or Family Search.

The source and internet link of each record archives or depository is cited for easy reference, auditing and authentication purposes.
