Re: *Frederick & Walter Ferris*

Kwey Algonquin Tribunal members,

I send this package on behalf of the Mattawa North Bay Algonquin First Nation members who descend from Frederick & Walter Ferris.

The dispute in front of the Tribunal is to determine if evidence exist to keep Frederick Ferris and/or Walter Ferris on the list of Algonquin Ancestors.

Who is the Joseph Ferris on the 1901 Census record in Cameron Township ?

Joan Holmes is correct in saying that the Joseph Ferris on the 1901 Census in Cameron Township cannot be the Joseph Walter Ferris who died in 1897.

- 1- Cameron Township borders the Town of Mattawa to the East.
- 2- The Joseph Ferris on the 1901 Census record was born on abt May 15, 1873 in Ontario.
- 3- Joseph Ferris was buried in Mattawa on July 3, 1913 at the age of 35 years. (Born abt. 1878) and states that he was the child of the deceased Joseph Ferris.
- 4- His long form death states that he was born at the Mouth Riviere Dumoine, QC and that his father was Joseph Ferris.
- 5- Joseph Ferris also appears on the 1891 Census in Maria and Clara, Renfrew North and 18 years old. (Born 1873)

Who is the father of Joseph Ferris ?

His father is listed as Joseph Ferris on his death records. We believe that his father is the brother of Walter Ferris and son of Frederick Ferris.

- 1- His father Joseph Ferris appears with his father Frederick Ferris, his mother and siblings (including Walter Ferris) on the 1861 census record and shows him as born in abt 1845 in Lower Canada. On the same census record on the left side of the page is a hand drawn map of the Ottawa River with the Dumoine River listed as flowing into the Ottawa River. Remember that on the long form death record of 1913, his son Joseph is shown to have been born at the Mouth of the

Dumoine River. Coincidence ? We think NOT...

2- He is listed again on the 1871 census again in Riviere Creuse, Pontiac North. (Born 1847 and birth place listed as Quebec)

Our position is that the father of Joseph Ferris listed as Algonquin on the 1901 Census is Joseph Ferris who is the brother of Walter Ferris and son of Frederick Ferris and Ann Nancy Good.

Once again, our position is that Walter Ferris should remain on the list of Algonquin Ancestors as him and his family are listed on several historical documents as ALGONQUINS. Regardless of where they were born. These individuals were Hudson Bay employees and moved around. According to Joan Holmes, Frederick Ferris' father may have been Hugh Faries. Hugh Faries was from the Montreal area and not out west. We really don't know who the parents of Frederick Ferris are.

Again the individuals against these ancestors have not demonstrated that Walter Ferris is from another Indian Nation, however the evidence on hand shows Walter Ferris , and now his brother Joseph Ferris' son and Walter's entire family are listed as Algonquins.

I've attached the documents discussed above.

This has been very hard on their families and would hope that this information will help with your deliberations. Let me know if you require any clarification.
