Kwey Algonquin Tribunal members,

I send this package on behalf of the Mattawa North Bay Algonquin First Nation members who descend from Frederick & Walter Ferris.

The dispute in front of the Tribunal is to determine if evidence exist to keep Frederick Ferris and/or Walter Ferris on the list of Algonquin Ancestors.

**Facts:** Walter Ferris was born out of the Territory, No one is disputing this. There is no document that either Chief Wendy Jocko, Chief Greg Sarazin, Darryl Leroux or Joan Holmes presented that list either Walter Ferris or his father with another Indian Nation. Their argument is that because they were born outside the Territory, they can't be Algonquin and must be from another Indian Nation. If there was no other evidence and this was the sole basis to make a decision, one may agree. This is NOT the only evidence.

**Facts:** Walter Ferris, his spouse Annie McDonell and all their children are all listed as ALGONQUIN on the 1901 census in Mattawa. Walter and Annie's son Joseph Ferris is also listed as ALGONQUIN on the 1901 census in Cameron Township. Walter Ferris, Annie McDonell, their daughter Mary Margaret, their son John, his wife and children are all listed as ALGONQUIN and INDIAN on the 1921 census in Mattawa.

Now Joan Holmes says that the word Algonquin is crossed off and replaced with the word Indian on this 1921 census in Mattawa. This is the case with many known Algonquins in this 1921 census. I have provided examples where there are know Algonquins such as my own great great grandmother Madeleine Natowesi and her children, the Dufond family and Leclaire family all being crossed off as Algonquins and added Indians. All these individuals are certified Algonquins. Joan Holmes can comment on this. We don't know why this was done to Algonquins on this census, but it doesn't hold water. It's not because they're not Algonquin.

**Our position is that Walter Ferris should remain on the list of Algonquin Ancestors as him and his family are listed on several historical documents as ALGONQUINS.** Regardless of where they were born. These individuals were Hudson Bay employees and moved around.


According to Joan Holmes, Frederick Ferris' father may have been Hugh Faries. Hugh Faries was from the Montreal area and not out west. We really don't know who his parents are.

**Again the individuals against these ancestors have not demonstrated that Walter Ferris is from another Indian Nation, however the evidence on hand shows Walter Ferris and his entire family as Algonquins.**

I've attached other documents for your reference as proof of the above.

This has been very hard on their families and would hope that this information will help with your deliberations. Let me know if you require any clarification.
